STOP PRESS: AGENCY WORKERS REGULATIONS TO BE REVIEWED

The Secretary of State for BIS has confirmed in the House of Commons that the Agency Workers Regulations 2010 (due to come into force on 1 October 2011) are under review.

Edward Davey stated “The Government are aware of the different points of view expressed by the business community about certain aspects of the agency workers regulations and is currently considering the way forward.”

The Regulations currently seek to give agency workers equal rights as their permanent counterparts in respect of pay, annual leave and other working conditions.

Changes to the Regulations resulting from the Coalition Government review, will be of particular interest to employment businesses and end users.

Further information regarding the results of the Government review will be provided when available.
